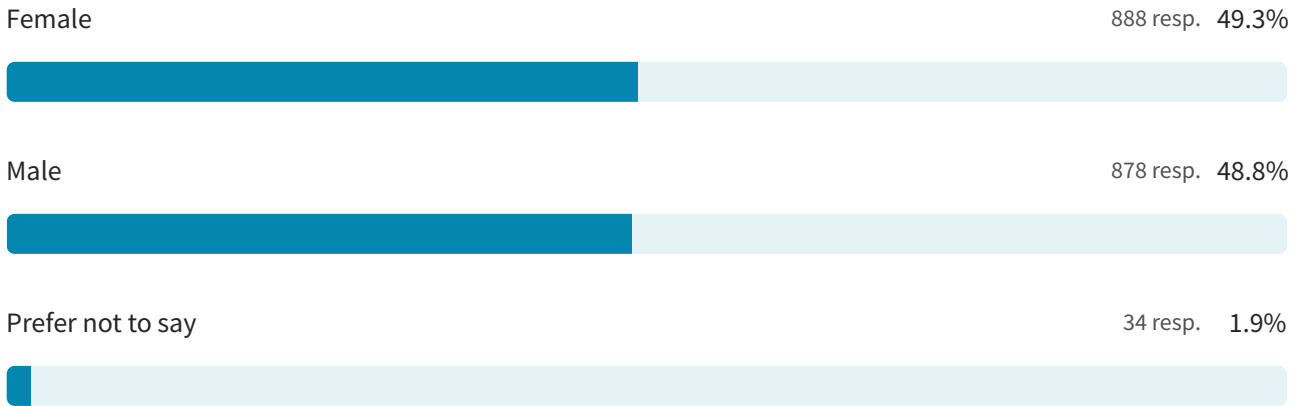

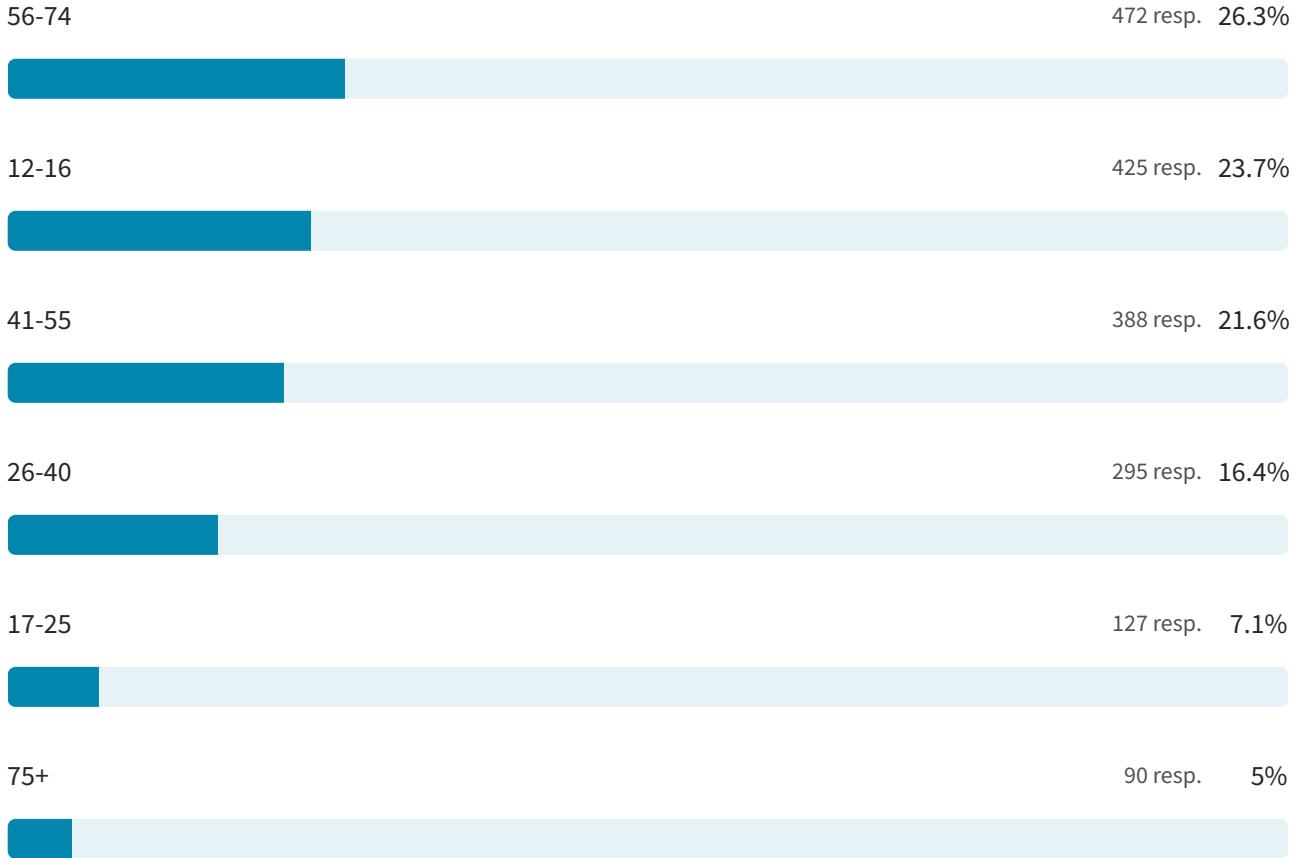
What is your gender?

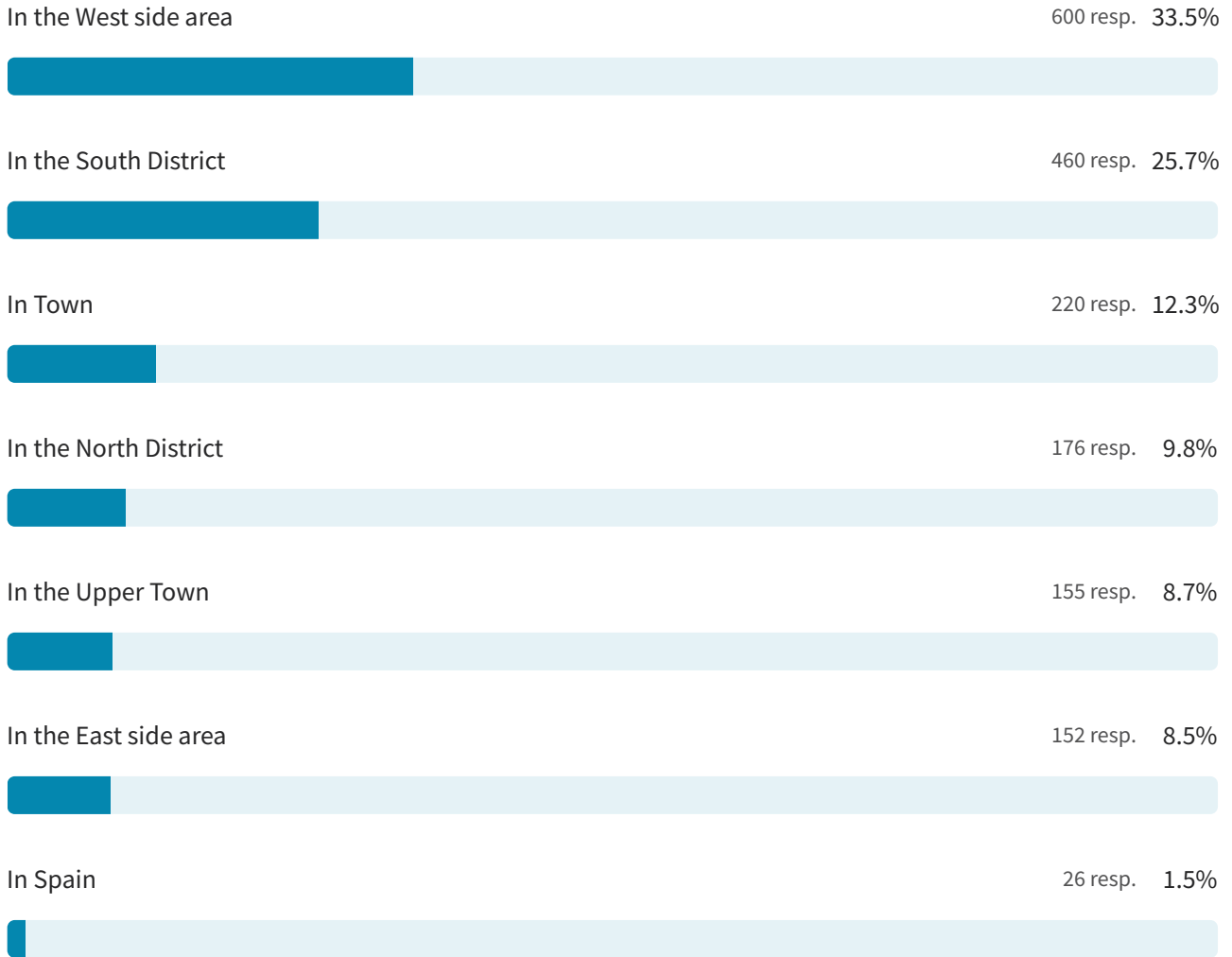
Please choose the age group that is relevant to you

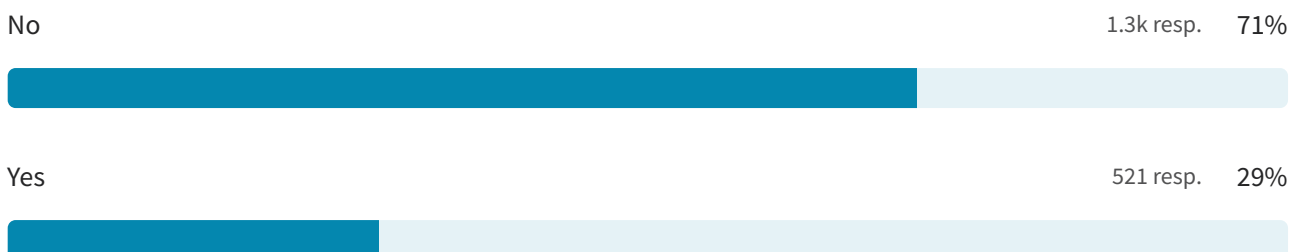
Where do you live?

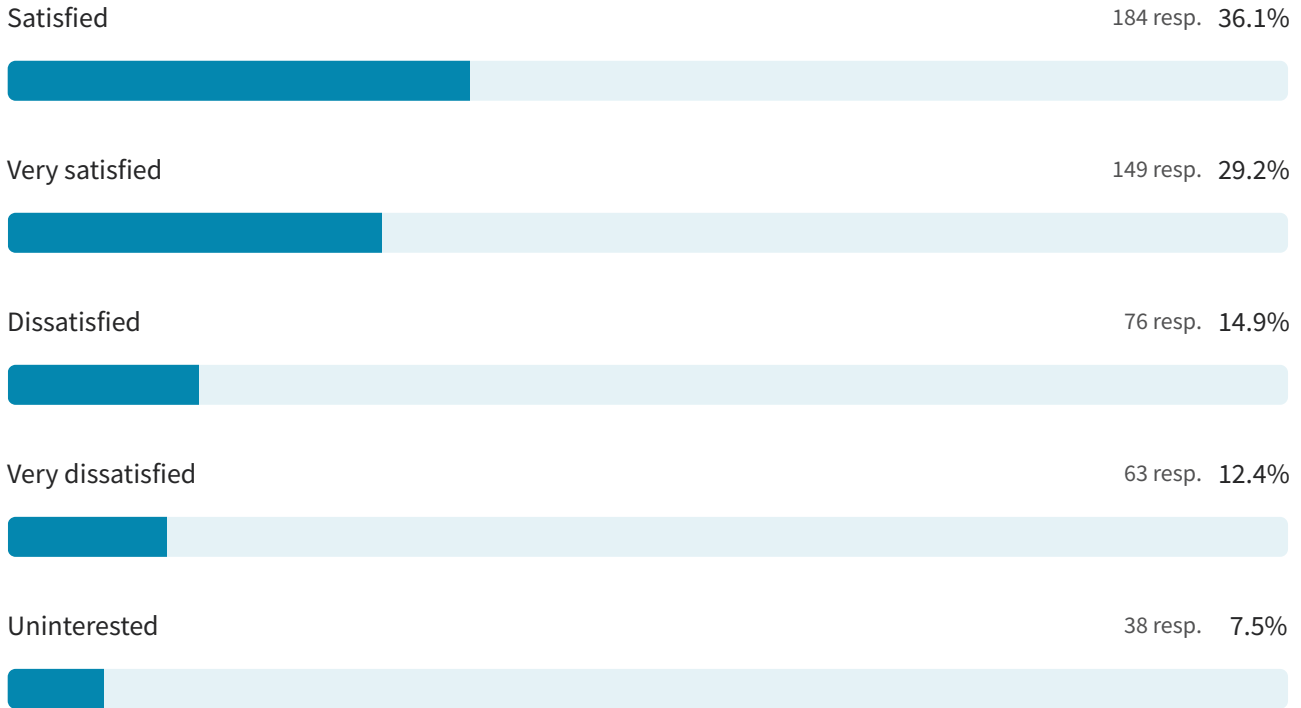
Have you had any contact with the RGP in the last 12 months?

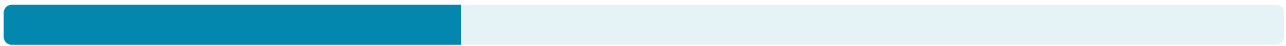

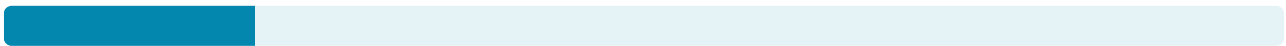

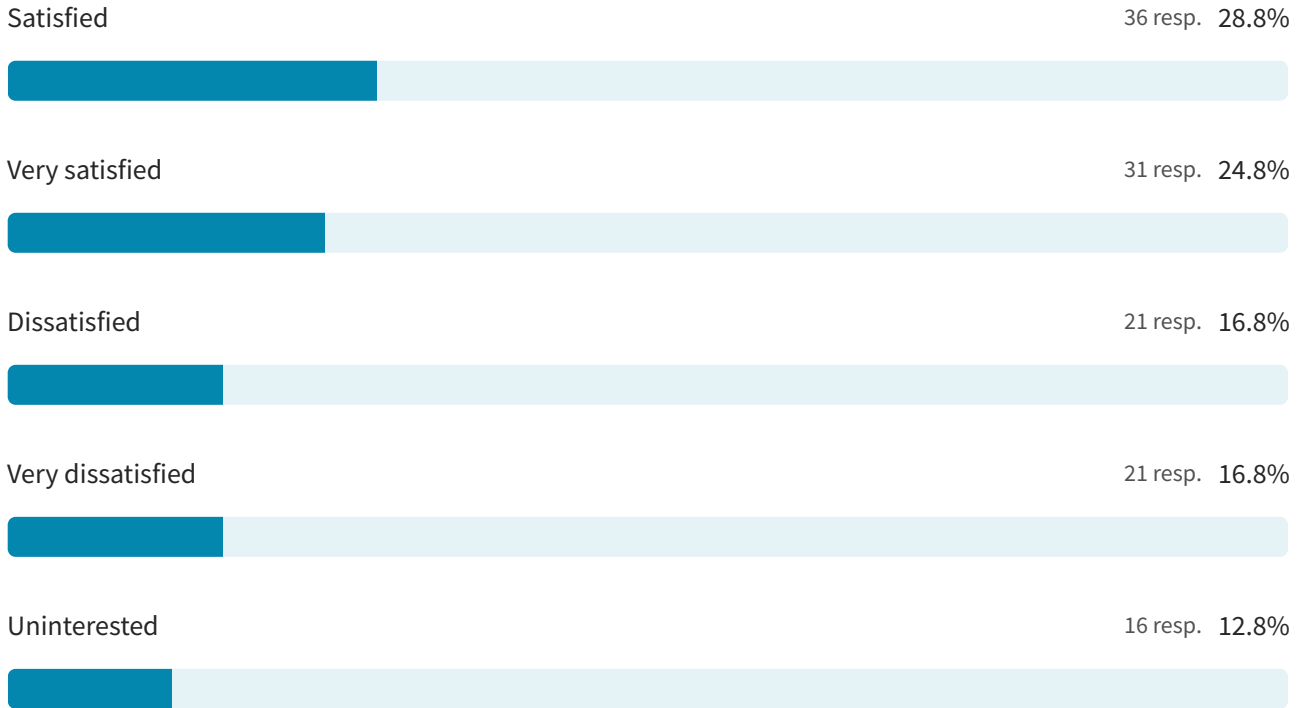

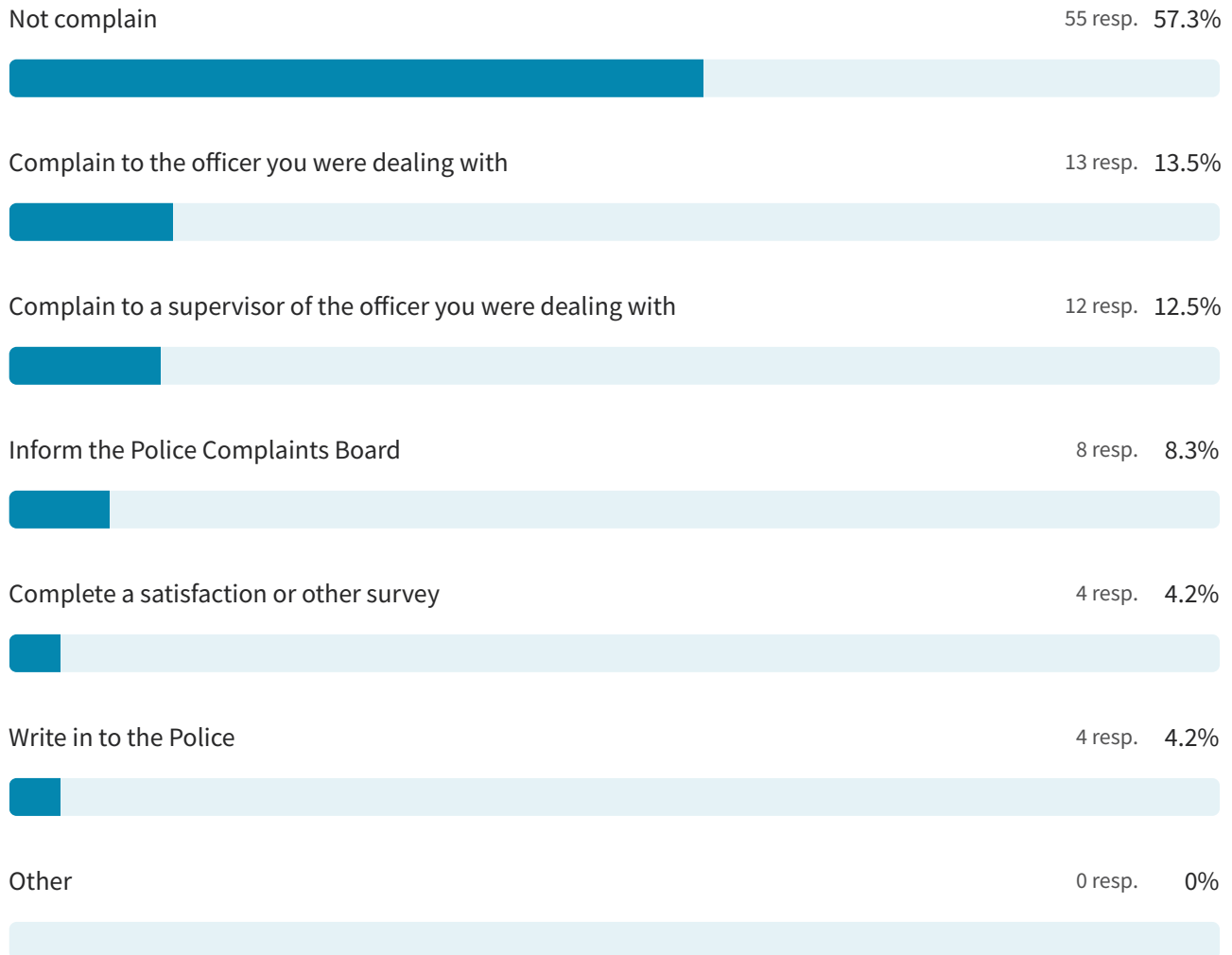
How satisfied were you with the manner & efficiency in which the RGP handled your case?

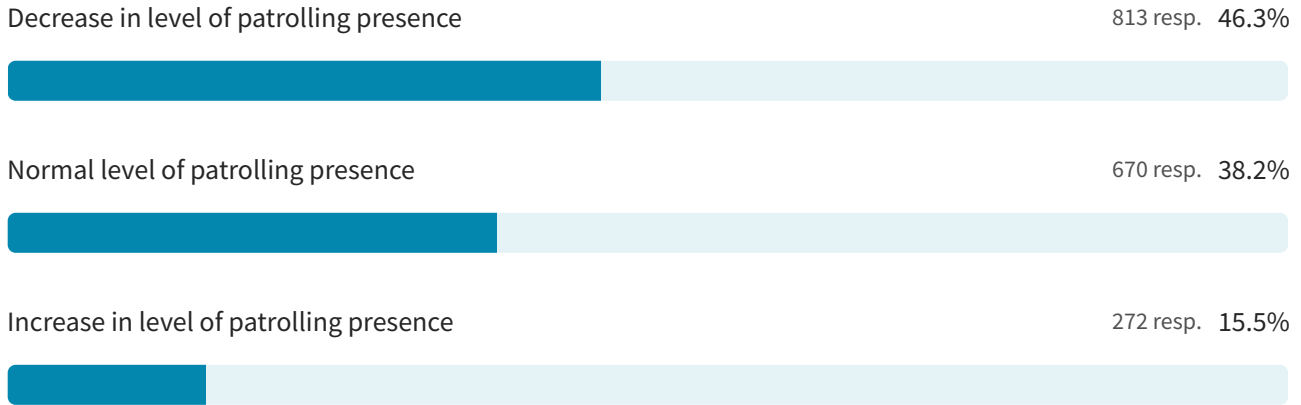

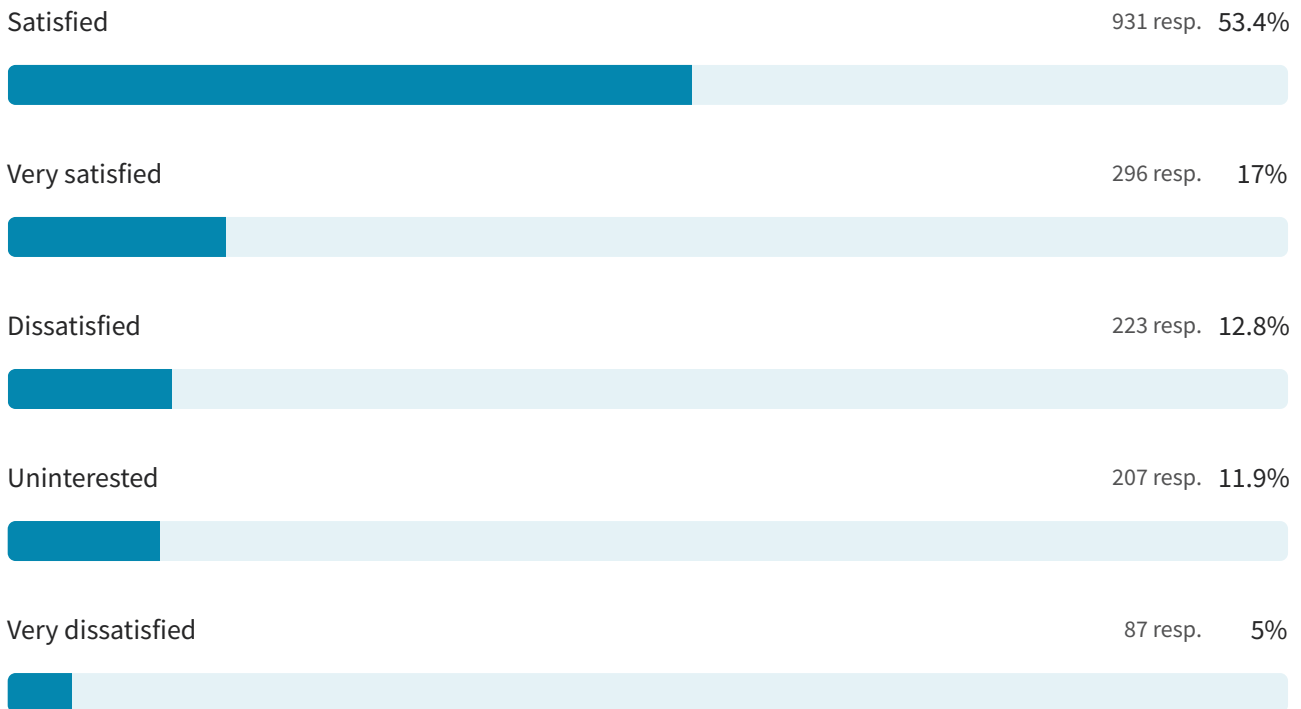
